Charging your Chromebook

Update your Chromebook

Google releases a new Chromebook update about two times per month. To check for updates complete the following:

- 1) Open "Settings."
- 2) Click the three lines in the top left corner.
- 3) On the left-hand side, click "About ChromeOS."
- 4) Click "Check for Updates."

If an update is available, your Chromebook will show a percentage until it reaches 100%. It may stay at 100% for a minute.
